Commander's Column

The Department of Illinois has begun sending dues notices to members for 2013 fiscal year. I'm happy to say that a significant number of our members have paid promptly. This puts us on course to achieve 100 percent sooner than last year with the possibility to win an award if accomplished by December of this year.

Todd Hanson, Bill Downing and I representing Post 80, attended the Department Convention. Jack Border also attended representing District 11 as incoming Commander.

Thursday afternoon, the 25 Districts caucused individually to recommend action on 46 resolutions. An example Resolution #39 Resolved, By the American Legion, Department of Illinois, convention assembled 11-14 July 2012, in Springfield, Illinois, that the Department of Illinois shall sponsor and support legislation to amend 20 ILCS 2805 Section 2.01 to read: An individual who served in a time of conflict as set forth in subsection (a)(1) of this section or who qualifies for VA medical care based on a service connected medical condition or disability has preference over all other qualifying candidates, for purposes of eligibility for domiciliary or nursing home care at any Illinois Veterans Home. The accepted resolutions are then presented to the convention delegates for the National Convention to be held in Indianapolis starting August 24th.

There were several guest speakers Friday during convention. The first was Judy Barr Topinka, Comptroller, who reiterated her support for veterans and to do everything in her power to make sure the vets receive their state benefits. A representative from VA reported on the progress being made on new claims. He expressed his frustration because of the need for more manpower to process the claims. The State Director for the IDVA came with her administrators for the veterans homes Manteno, LaSalle, Anna, and Quincy. Each administrator reported on improvements being at each facility and thanking the various Posts that help supporting those facilities.


GIFT FOR YANKS

Standing above the crowd

When I was a boy about 8 years old my mom & dad took the family on a vacation to Vermont. I remember we had a fine time, but one sight sticks out in my mind above all else.

While driving thru the rural countryside we rounded a bend and saw a huge boulder alongside the highway. It was larger than our car! To my surprise there was writing upon it. Not graffiti, but neat lines of words carefully chiseled.

Engraved upon the side was the Lord's Prayer--each and every word. Nearby, a roadside historic plaque told a most unusual story.

Apparently long ago this was a very muddy dirt roadway and at this very spot horses & buggies often got mired in the mud. Often these drivers, with hard work and bad luck, trying to push and pull horses in an effort to get going again, was accompanied by terrible cursing and four-letter words.

One day a minister, travelling this early highway, came upon this muddy turmoil. While sitting there listening to all this profanity and waiting to get through himself, suddenly got an idea. Seeing this huge nearby boulder he decided to begin cutting man's best known prayer into the rock! He came back several days and finished the job. Then a strange thing happened. The bad language ceased almost immediately! The Lord's Prayer Rock had done its job, and instead of hot tempers, God's Peace prevailed, even to this day!

The point is that one person stood above the rest. He set an example. He alone made a difference, because he dared to act calmly and rationally, using the talents God blessed him with. His act has lived for ages as an inspiration for others.
