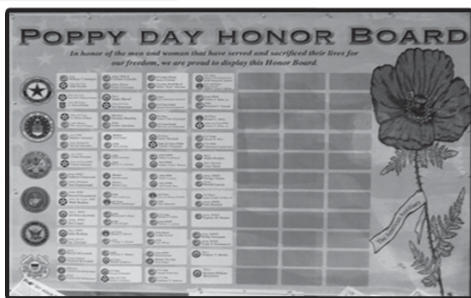

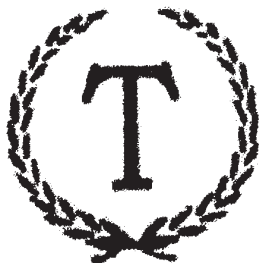

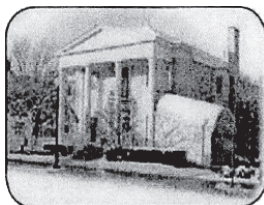

If you are in need of your **DD 214** go to the following website:

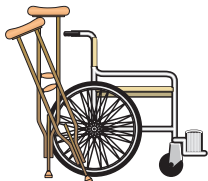
www.archives.gov/veterans/military-service-records

Then go to Start your Military Service Record (DD Form 214) Request and follow the prompts and fill in the required information. It also has you print a signature sheet that you have to mail to them. When they receive the signature paper, they will send you an email confirming that they received it. Then in about 10 days, you'll receive 2 certified copies of your DD 214 and copies of your discharge orders.

It's really easy and it only costs you the price of a postage stamp and an envelope.

The Village of Downers Grove will be installing a sidewalk at the corner of 41st & Saratoga, which has been previously landscaped with bushes and flowers above a flagstone retaining wall. Some Mugho Pines were transplanted along the driveway by the Pavilion last fall, but died over the winter. The remaining landscaping was scheduled to be disposed of by the Village's contractor.
