



## LEGION RIDER UPDATE



### Presentation to Midwest Homeless Shelter for Veterans

On October 29<sup>th</sup>, the Legion Riders along with several of our collaborators from Global Hope presented our donation from the Jammin4Vets Concert to Robert Adams, Executive Director for The **Midwest Shelter for Homeless Veterans (MSHV)**.

The **Midwest Shelter for Homeless Veterans** is a not-for-profit transitional living facility that provides assistance to U.S. veterans of any era for the opportunity to return to useful and productive lives by providing them with the skills for independent living.

Since the Shelter opened in 2007, twenty-nine veterans have gone through the program. The MSHV program has a 71% success rate (meaning that veterans are housed, employed and substance free) upon completion of the program, with 66 percent of the vets remaining housed, employed and substance free after one year. The average length of stay for a veteran is 9 months.

MSHV is the only veteran specific transitional housing program in DuPage County. The MSHV program has been cited as the model program for a transitional housing facility in Illinois by the VA Medical Center at Hines Hospital and by the Illinois Department of Veterans Affairs.





## Accident Scene Management Course – Advanced

The Legion Riders are planning to take the all day Accident Scene Management Course – Advanced Course (ASMC) at Loyola Medical Center on December 17, 2011. This Certificate Training Program equips Legion Riders to come to the immediate assistance of injured victims at motorcycle or auto accident sites and to work with emergency responders in assisting accident victims. ## RENTAL INFORMATION MEETING

My name is Dave Wisbrock and I am the new rental agent for Post 80. I can be reached by phone at 630-8084544. I would like to have a meeting with all members who are interested in being a representative of the Legion during future rentals.

I want all representatives to know who I am and I would like to know who they are. There are guidelines for all representatives to follow and I want to be sure we all know and follow them. The duties are listed here and it would be great if you brought this page of the newsletter with you to this meeting.

The Hall Representative shall be responsible for the smooth and efficient running of the rental event that he/she is assigned. In carrying out this responsibility, the Hall Rental Representative shall do the following.

1. Ensure that the hall and/or outdoor facilities are set up as planned.
2. Open Hall and stay for client decorating and set up( 2 hours max.)
3. Open Hall one hour prior to start of event( let in bartender, caterers, etc.)
4. Turn on required equipment - AC, lights, heat, fans, parking lot lights, etc.
5. Welcome client and party guests, handle all client requests.
6. Keep entrance and foyer free from moisture, snow and any hazards.
7. Be in attendance during the entire event and assist bartenders if requested.
8. Take all responsible care to ensure open liquor does not leave the building during indoor events or leave the designated areas during outdoor events.
9. No outside liquor or soda is allowed to be brought into the building in accordance with Downers Grove liquor laws.
10. Be aware of the location of the defibrillator.



**RENTAL INFO CONTINUED**

11. Supervise security staff, if applicable, hired for the event and/or call for police assistance to maintain orderly control of the event.
12. Periodically empty trash and reline garbage cans as necessary.
13. After event ensure that the kitchen, bar, lounge and hall are clean and all garbage is put in the dumpsters.
14. Turn off all parking lot lights, sound system, TV's, interior lights and fans.
15. Open sliding wall if it was closed for event, open lounge door to foyer.
16. Check washrooms before leaving building.
17. Turn off all lights at the control panel
18. Be sure all exit doors are closed and locked.
19. Arm the security system when leaving.

I know this sounds like a lot of things to do, but these are really only common sense. Compensation is by the event. I hope I didn't scare anyone away. Please remember to bring this article with you to the meeting.


