


Panoramic Photo Update



A package of four screenings to identify risk for stroke, heart disease and other chronic conditions will be offered.



On June 3,2023 the Strawberry moon was caught at the point of the obelisk at Post 80. This obelisk at 30 feet is the tallest veteran's memorial in Du Page County and holds the names of over 1000 veterans both living and deceased. DD 214 REQUESTS

If you are in need of your **DD 214** go to the following website:

www.archives.gov/veterans/military-servicerecords

Then go to Start your Military Service Record (DD Form 214) Request and follow the prompts and fill in the required information. It also has you print a signature sheet that you have to mail to them. When they receive the signature paper, they will send you an email confirming that they received it. Then in about 10 days, you'll receive 2 certified copies of your DD 214 and copies of your discharge orders.

It's really easy and it only costs you the price of a postage stamp and an envelope.
