
Bring along your summer vacation stories, we would like to hear from you. As a group, we can plan some interesting programs and continue with ones we have already established.



DD 214 REOUESTS

If you are in need of your **DD 214** go to the following website:

www.archives.gov/veterans/military-servicerecords

Then go to Start your Military Service Record (DD Form 214) Request and follow the prompts and fill in the required information. It also has you print a signature sheet that you have to mail to them. When they receive the signature paper, they will send you an email confirming that they received it. Then in about 10 days, you'll receive 2 certified copies of your DD 214 and copies of your discharge orders.

It's really easy and it only costs you the price of a postage stamp and an envelope.
